


6) Past and Coming Projects that we are in.





8) Letter from our one volunteer:



"We had very difficult visa process before our travels to European Union Countries. However, we were not enough optimistic to overcome such a deep issue like that on our own untill the 11th of December in 2010. When the 11th of December came out, we participated to the workshop called "Visa:Barrier in front of civil society" which is organized by the *European Union General Secretariat in Turkey*. After the workshop, there was an important decision taken which encouraged us and became the first spark of our Project."




